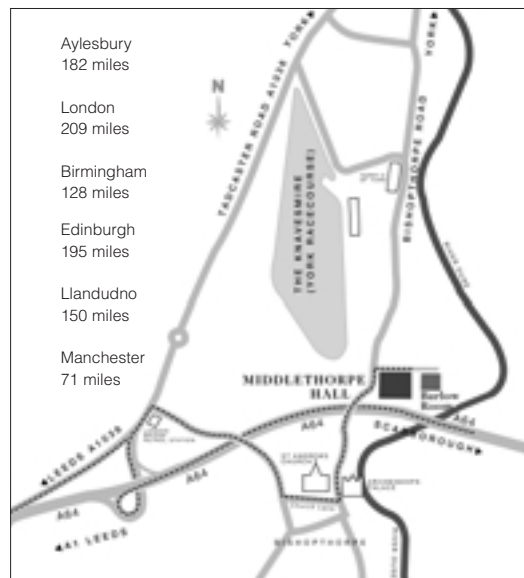


How to travel to Middlethorpe Hall

By road – Take the A64 (T) off the A1 (T) near Tadcaster, follow the signs to York West, then follow the smaller signs to Bishopthorpe, then Middlethorpe.

By rail – The nearest station is York to which there is an excellent and very fast train service from London, Edinburgh and most parts of Britain. The journey from London takes only 1 hour 50 minutes.

By Air – Manchester International Airport is just 11/2 hours drive. Leeds International is a 45 minute drive.
