Syndicate rooms are available from **£300** for the Henry Keene, **£400** for the Eric Throssell or **£800** for either the James Wyatt or James Gibbs rooms.

Dining at Hartwell

Meeting groups will be allocated an appropriate private room i.e. the Doric or Octagon dining rooms. Dress code is smart (although jacket and tie for gentleman are not obligatory): trainers, tracksuits and shorts are not acceptable.

Private lunches or dinners will incur a room hire charge of **£250** for the Octagon and **£350** for the Doric dining rooms.

Activities

A range of outdoor activities such as clay pigeon shooting, archery, quad biking etc can be organised either using hotel grounds or adjacent land.
