

The Bodysgallen Experience

Bodysgallen Hall offers a warm welcome as you pass through it's ancient front door into the oak-panelled hall, where sofas invite you to relax in comfort by the fireside. This historic house is filled with antique furniture and eclectic objects, enjoying a sense of well-being.

The approach to the Hall is along a winding drive lined with snowdrops in February and daffodils in March. As this opens out to gardens and parkland, the Hall comes into view guarded by an ancient Stone Pine.

From within, the stone mullioned windows reveal views of the award-winning gardens, once over-grown through neglect but now totally restored to present all-year-round interest. Through the parted bank of trees beyond the gardens, Conwy Castle can be seen, with a backdrop of the majestic Eryri (Snowdonia) mountain range. Commanding the side of Mount Pydew, Bodysgallen Hall's location offers a panoramic view from Conwy Valley to the Llandudno corniche, with the Great and Little Orme on either side.

Bodysgallen's unique microclimate nurtures a flourishing kitchen garden, providing an abundance of seasonal produce. The close collaboration between the Head Chef and the Head Gardener ensures that fresh fruit and vegetables are incorporated into the menus to provide seasonal delights. While much is cultivated on-site, other ingredients are sourced from local suppliers, the emphasis on provenance enhancing the fine dining experience, and offering a taste of Welsh cuisine inspired by the estate gardens and surroundings.

'Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty'



Standing in 20 acres of its own award winning gardens and parkland this glorious William and Mary House was formerly the home of the famous 18th century traveller and diarist, Lady Mary Wortley Montagu. It is an ideal base for exploring the many attractions of York, including York Minster, Jorvik Viking experience, The Treasurer's House, Fairfax House, York Railway Museum and the medieval street of The Shambles. Further afield, North Yorkshire is full of romantic and historic places, such as the ruined abbeys of Fountains, Rievaulx and Jervaulx, country houses such as Castle Howard, Newby Hall and Beningbrough.

The twenty-seven comfortable bedrooms are located in the main house and the adjacent 18th century courtyard, with an additional two cottage suites.
